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Various Regional Trips

Donaustauf Castle Ruin

- Castle built by 914 und 930 von Bishop Tuto of Regensburg
- Weir system within the triangle Duchy of Bavaria, Hochstift Regensburg (*secular authority*) and Free Imperial City of Regensburg.



Chinese Tower

- Originally constructed in 1842
- 1880: the palace burnt down but the tower survived
- 1902: Dismantled and rebuilt in the castle garden of Pruefening
- 1999: Rebuilt and inaugurated in the Princely Park of Donaustauf



Walhalla

- 1830: The Foundation stone was laid in Donaustauf
- Master builder: Leo von Klenze
- 1842: Inaugurated by Bavarian King Ludwig I.
- Shows busts of important and famous persons.



The Princely Thiergarten (= animal park)

- Since 1813 this area is the hunting forest of the Princes of Thurn und Taxis
- Area of nearly 11 square miles with big old trees, meadows, creeks and ponds and intact fauna
- Golf course of the Golf- und Landclub Regensburg

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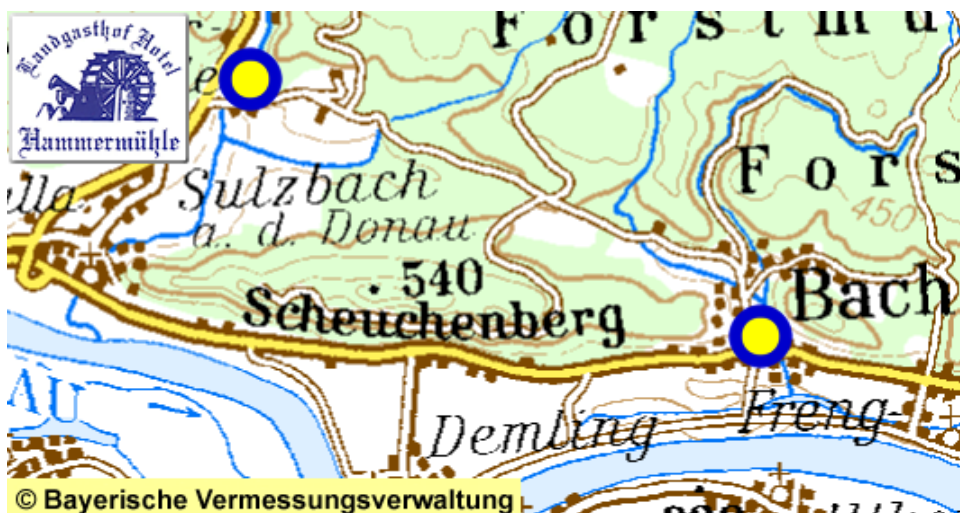


Various Regional Trips
